Route: Igor's Alley 3.7 Miles

South on Atlantic
Right on Bixby
Left on Locust
Right on Cameron
Right on Pine
Left on 37th
Right on Country Club
Right on Stewart

Left into the alley

- At the 3rd house on the left, Look up over the garage to see the “**Door to Nowhere**” – site of Igor’s house and murder site
- Continue through alley

Right on Pacific
Left on San Antonio
Right on Locust
Left on Roosevelt
Left on Elm
Right on Carson
Left on Atlantic

Return to It's A Grind

IGOR'S ALLEY

1. The legend of Igor, or “Igor’s Alley” as it is commonly known, is this: Igor was a crazy midget, and one night, Igor completely lost it, stabbing his wife and children before hanging them outside their house (which butted on an alley) on meat hooks.

2. Igor’s house—a looming blot of a thing with a visible exterior doorframe on the second floor and no stairwell or porch connected to it. Then, legend holds, Igor hanged someone from “some sort of hook” from the door.
